This new online summer course introduces students to the field of border studies by way of six key themes:

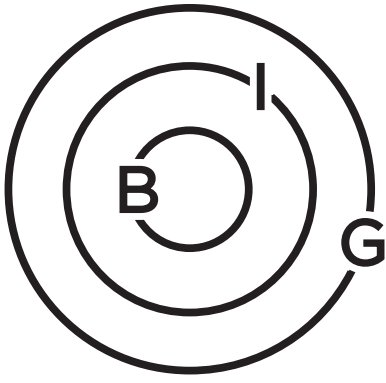
- (1) Borders and history,**

The course draws on fascinating case studies that illustrate the current progressive and transformative challenges occurring in and around the borders of Canada, and in particular Ontario. The course material is delivered through a diversity of media (video-clips, power points with voice over, and readings). At the end of the course, students will convene for one week to participate in tutorial discussions at Carleton University and a class fieldtrip. The course is directed toward senior undergraduate and graduate students, as well as government employees and other professionals working in relevant fields.
